FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an attended, and unattended burial, the burial fee ¹	£1189.00
In this local area, the typical cost for a burial is	£1189.00
For a new grave, you will need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you will need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge several other fees	£1683.00
For an attended cremation funeral, the local cremation fee ²	£1078.00
In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for a local resident	£1078.00

This fee also includes: (Medical referee charge: £31.50, Environmental surcharge: £115.50)
